

IANTD Normoxic Trimix Diver (Closed Circuit) Course Information

The IANTD CCR Normoxic Trimix Diver course is aimed at those rebreather divers who wish to extend their skills and experience to safely dive deeper than 39msw in a safe and controlled manner.

Qualification

Upon certification, you will be qualified to dive to 60msw using diluent and bailout mixes containing helium.

Prerequisites

You should hold an Advanced Nitrox or Advanced Recreational Trimix Diver qualification, or equivalent, with over 100 logged dives. At least 30 of these dives must be deeper than 27msw. You will also need to be a qualified diver on your chosen rebreather, along with having at least 20 dives and 25hours logged. However, we would always recommend that you aim closer to 50hours before considering attending a CCR Normoxic Trimix Diver course. You should be comfortable in the water and have competence completing basic diving skills (mask skills, DSMB deployment etc.) mid-water while maintaining neutral buoyancy.

Equipment Requirements

You will be provided with the IANTD CCR Normoxic Trimix Diver Student Kit, including the IANTD *Exploration and Mixed Gas Encyclopaedia – The Tao of Survival Underwater* and tables for dive planning. In addition you will need your chosen model of Closed Circuit Rebreather, along with a primary buoyancy device, dive computer / depth timer, basic dive kit (inc. SMB & Reel / Spool and a slate or notebook) and two bailout / stage cylinders with regulators (all in oxygen service). We recommend aluminium stage cylinders.

Course Structure

The IANTD CCR Normoxic Trimix Diver course runs over 5 days. Day 1 is spent in the classroom where you will complete theory sessions, classroom practical problems, equipment workshops and dry skills. The remaining days are spent at the dive site completing various skills and dives. In between dives, you will also complete additional theory sessions and further dry skills and workshops.

Courses can be structured to run consecutively over 5 days, or split over a number of sessions.

Costs

The IANTD CCR Normoxic Trimix Diver course is £700.00 per person. This price includes the training and materials outlined above. Certification costs are also included (providing certification criteria are met).

The following are not included in the course fee: Dive Site costs (inc. entry, accommodation, food, travel etc.), Gas and Sofnolime (if appropriate).

Evaluation / Assessment

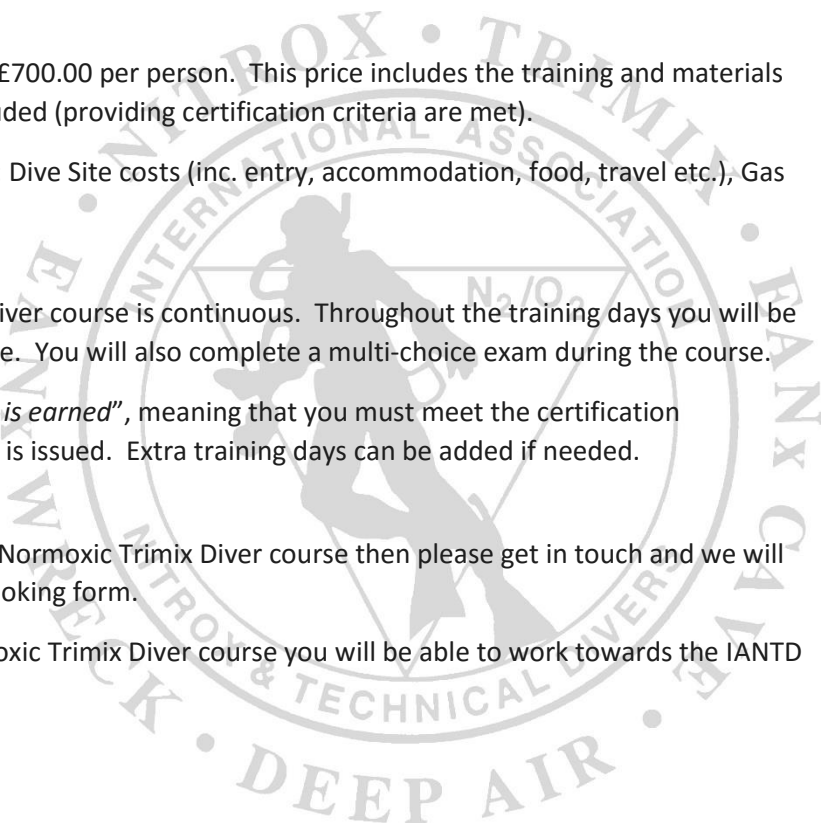
Evaluation on the IANTD CCR Normoxic Trimix Diver course is continuous. Throughout the training days you will be assessed on your skills, performance and attitude. You will also complete a multi-choice exam during the course.

With IANTD “*Training is purchased, Certification is earned*”, meaning that you must meet the certification requirements and standards before certification is issued. Extra training days can be added if needed.
